Since 2007 he has been member of Rovigo's Accademia dei Concordi (Academy of Arts, Science and Fine Arts established in 1580) and since 2017 member of its Board of Directors. Since 2017 he has been Director of RILA Rassegna Italiana di Linguistica Applicata founded in 1969, one of the Italian most prestigious journals on applied linguistics and since 2019 co-editor of ISSA. His main research interests revolve around foreign language education (in particular Italian, English and Spanish as second/foreign languages), bilingualism and multilingualism, the teaching of the sociolinguistic aspects of foreign languages, sociolinguistics and language policies.

He has held seminars, courses and conferences in about 40 countries worldwide. He is author of more than 140 publications (among volumes, essays, articles and reviews).
